

Coach Educator

Objectives

• To lead the process of educating club coaches, to raise the overall standard of coaching and ensure retention and development of players

Responsibilities

- Prepare and deliver a coach development workshop comprising both theory and practical components at the pre-season Education Roadshow.
- Attend designated events to observe coaches in match situations and provide feedback.
- Develop templates to provide written feedback to coaches and their clubs.
- Prepare and deliver coach development workshops that build upon the common themes identified through coaching observations.
- Develop effective communication channels that provides access to resources and information and that encourages sharing of knowledge and experience.
- Foster a culture of co-operation amongst coaches of all clubs that has a positive impact on retention, recruitment, and the overall growth of the code.
- Encourage coaches to pursue a higher level of formal accreditation and to participate in coaching activities at higher levels above club.

Qualifications and experience

- Current coaching accreditation, higher level is preferable
- Experience in coaching roles
- Experience in teaching, coaching, or mentoring adults
- Strong communication and planning skills
- Valid Working with Children Check

Note: coaching experience and accreditation within AFL are preferable, however a similar background in another sport will be considered.
