# **Objectives**

• To lead the planning and implementation of the North Coast Force representative program to ensure co-ordination of effort and philosophy across all teams

# Responsibilities

- Proactively promote the program to encourage the involvement of players, coaches, and support staff
- Set the program dates, including trials, training, and matches, culminating with the Northern NSW carnival in July
- Lead the process to select and appoint coaches and support staff for all teams
- Establish selection procedures to be used by all teams and support the coaches in making team selections
- Lead the process with coaches to determine a consistent North Coast Force playing style/game plan, and support coaches to develop a training plan to achieve this style
- Work with the North Coast Sport Science Co-ordinator to best utilise their skills within the program
- Devise the operational plan for Force teams' involvement in match days and carnivals including, but not limited to, designated team space, first aid, goal umpires, scouting, recovery
- Support the coaches in their professional development
