



AFL FUTURE LEADERS COMMUNITY PROGRAM

After a hugely successful pilot program in 2019, Youth Leadership training is back in 2020!

The purpose of the program is to teach leadership skills that will help participants in the sporting environment (on and off field), within their family life, at school, and in employment.

Who is the program for?

Male and female players aged 13 to 18 (born 2002 to 2007) that are interested in learning and improving leadership skills. Players **don't** have to be in a leadership role within their footy team to be eligible to be considered.

What's the commitment?

1. Completion of a two hour online program prior to attending the workshop
2. Half day of face to face training – Sunday 16 February in Coffs Harbour*
3. Undertaking a leadership role within local footy, e.g.:
 - Helping to coach club Auskick
 - Helping to coach a Junior team
 - Umpiring

* Workshop timings:

EMERGING LEADERS (16 to 18 years of age) – 9:00am to 1:00pm

ASPIRING LEADERS (13 to 15 years of age) – 1:00pm to 5:00pm

What's the cost of the program?

The cost of the program has been heavily subsidised by AFL NSW/ACT, with further subsidisation for female participants through the Office of Sport's Her Sport Her Way program. Cost is \$40 for male participants and \$20 for female participants, with each individual receiving a program hoodie.

How do I nominate?

How will selections be made?

AFL NSW/ACT staff will invite a maximum of 20 participants (per workshop) into the program.

When will I know if I've been selected?

All nominees will be advised whether they've been selected or not by Friday 6 February.
